LABORATORY 10: Body Fluids Differential

1. Introduction. The detection and identification of body fluids at a crime scene are very important aspects of forensic science. Determining whether or not there is a body fluid present and subsequently identifying it allows the sample to undergo further laboratory testing including DNA analysis which is a very crucial step in a wide range of investigations.

Body fluids, bodily fluids, or biofluids are liquids within the bodies of living people. In normal healthy men, the total body water is about 60% of the total body weight; it is slightly lower in women. A 70 kg (160 pound) man, then, has 42 liters of water in his body. This is divided between ICF and ECF in a two-to-one ratio: 28 liters are inside cells and 14 liters are outside cells.
